We're off to Magna Science Adventure Park where you can experience science in the zones of Earth, Air, Fire & Water. This is an interactive venue based in an old steel mill. They describe this as a 'coats-on' experience and we agree. There is a cafe on site for lunch and snacks.

❖ **Wednesday 22nd February National Railway Museum, York**



Discover over 300 years of history and over a million wonderful objects at The National Railway Museum in York. Marvel at iconic locomotives, watch engineering work in progress in the workshop or browse the object-filled warehouse. There is a restaurant on site. Wrap up warm!

❖ **Wednesday 28th March Royal Armouries, Leeds**

The Royal Armouries is Britain's national museum of arms and armour. There are over 8,500 objects on display in five galleries: War; Tournament; Oriental; Self Defence and Hunting – nobody is allowed to leave until they've been memorised in size order! Cafe on site.
