

YORKSHIRE DIRECTORY OF BLUESPACE VENUES

(including Open Water Swimming)

Open Country's 'Bluespace project' identified the need for a database about accessible bluespaces because, although each bluespace and water-based activity organisation usually have their own website, information about accessibility on these websites is often difficult to find. Here is an initial list of some bluespace venues across Yorkshire. The list is currently short, however it does present an early snapshot of bluespaces which are hopefully accessible for disabled people. The list includes lidos, beaches, swimming pools and lakes in Yorkshire, as well as some of the organisations that participated in our research project.

AccessAble provides information about wheelchair-friendly venues or disabled access and facilities at over 10,000 venues across the UK and Ireland. This includes places such as shops, pubs, restaurants, and cinemas, but also swimming pools: www.accessable.co.uk

At the fishing lake there are three Blue Badge parking bays and at the main reception North Yorkshire Water Park is adding resin pathways to help with access. There are accessible toilets.
